Details & Adjustments



The BC11 Series features a durable steel bed to support bales during pickup. Bed height is 2 ft. 7 in. to 4 ft. 6 in. based on model, and rises to 45-degrees when unloading. On the back, rugged rear tines keep bales secure in transport, and allow for an easier, softer release when dumping.



Adjustable loading arm offers the strength to lift heavy bales, and the gentle grip clutches each one without damage. Loading arm is compatible with a wide range of bales and tractor widths.

Up against a busy day? Lean on a BC11 carrier. A 45-degree dumping angle lets you line up each bale evenly for convenient storage. Or for greater efficiency, add a Frontier Inline Bale Wrapper. Our bale wrappers provide quality coverage and seal in rich nutrients in the silage.

Locked and loaded



Effective bale loading starts with a dependable loading arm. That's why Frontier Bale Carriers are equipped with a versatile bale arm that not only secures each bale without damaging valuable hay, but it rotates the bale before pickup, so you can follow the baler path, saving time and fuel in your chores.



Once you're fully loaded, it's time to move your bales...safely. The BC11 Series features a low-profile design to provide you with exceptional rear vision, ensuring a clear line of sight behind the implement. It also allows you to keep the loading arm in plain view throughout the loading cycle.



Need additional space for wider bales? Then adjust the bale guides (*highlighted*) to fit the bale diameters in your hay operation. Each bale guide is modified by moving the bar in or out. Set them to the proper angle, and then use the adjustment pin to lock them into place.



Frontier Bale Carriers are equipped with a powerful pusher to move bales rearward after loading. A 6 ft. 2 in. or 6 ft. 8 in. travel stroke helps make room for the next bale.



A hydraulic cylinder rests beneath the bed to provide a steady lift when it's time to dump bales for storage or wrapping.



Four flotation tires are attached to walking beams to provide a smoother ride over rough or uneven terrain.
