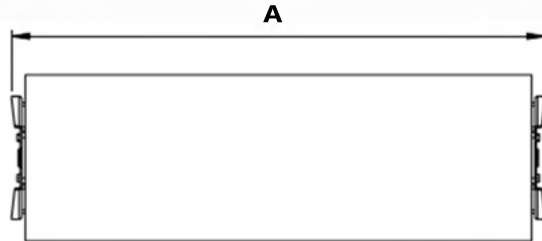
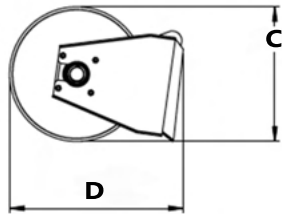
Standard Skid Steer Hook Up
