Intelligent Engine Braking (iEB™)**

- iEB puts you in control of your engine braking. From maximum to minimum engine braking, choose what suits you the best.

Optional DPS power steering adapts assistance according to vehicle speed:

- High assistance at low speed to reduce steering effort, lower assistance at high speed to give more terrain feeling to rider
